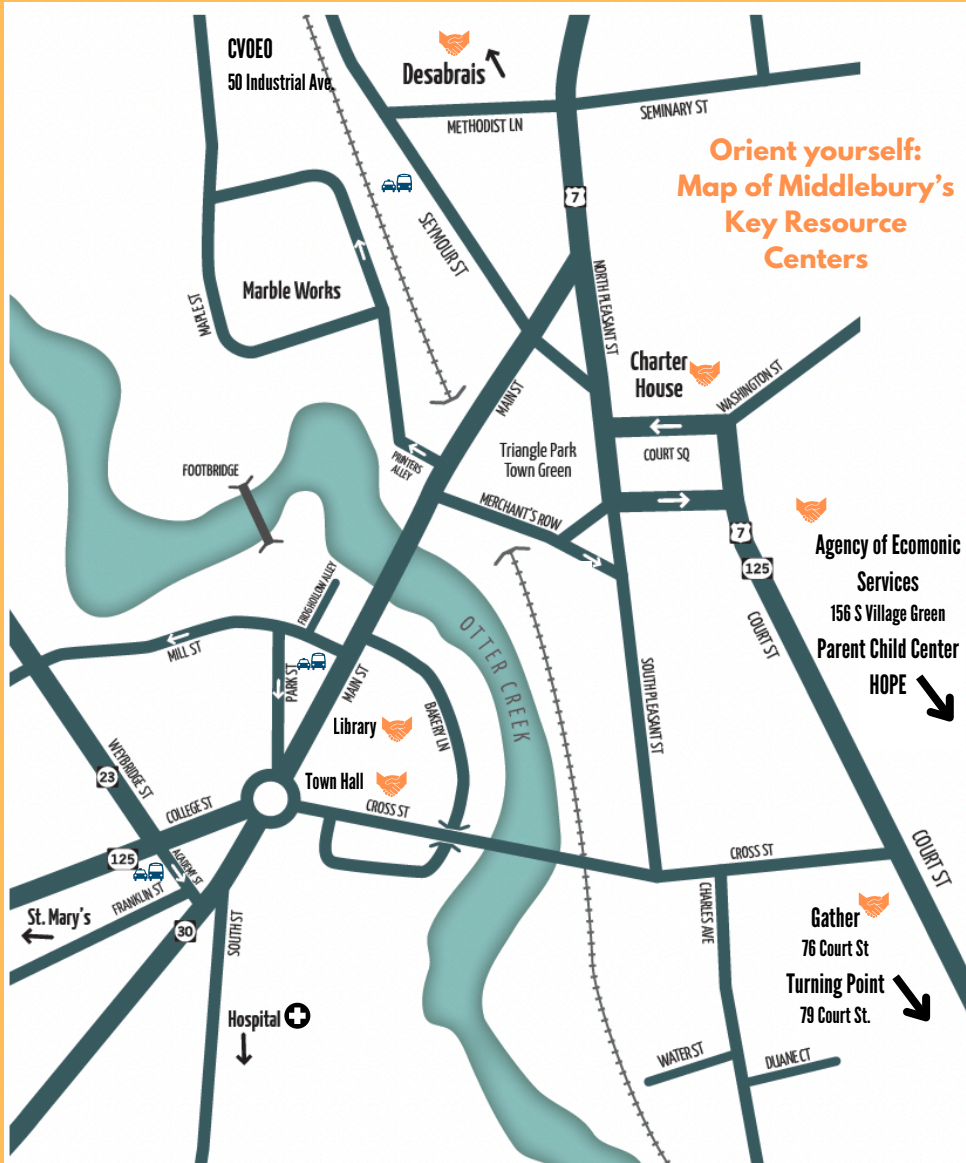

SIGNS OF HYPOTHERMIA & SEEKING HELP

- Shivering
- Chattering Teeth
- Exhaustion
- Clumsiness
- Confusion
- Sleepiness
- Rapid breathing, weak pulse
- Pale skin
- Trouble speaking/slurred speech

Frostbite Stages

- Cold/sore/painful
- Pins & needles
- Numbness

Move person to a warm, dry location. Remove wet clothes/replace with dry. Cover with jacket/hat/blanket. Apply heat.

CALL 911 and warm the person until help arrives
